

Health and Safety Guidelines for Working on the Farm in Fall 2020

For students enrolled in Animal Handling & Fitting Supervisor sections (11:067:176, Small ruminant, Cattle, Swine, Horse) and Horse Practicum (11:067:207) – Fall 2020

1. Students should arrive at their respective buildings (check SOC /Sakai for locations) and hand-sanitize.
2. Bags and personal belongings should be stored in your vehicle if possible. If this is not possible, there is limited locker space available in the barns.
3. Students should report a temp of under 100.4 F and sign a self-screening checklist that they are not experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, have not been exposed to a COVID-19 patient, or require quarantine due to other state mandates.
4. Masks are to be worn in the barns at all times, no exceptions. Face coverings must be worn properly and comply with CDC guidelines, and no mask exhaust valves are permitted.
5. Social distancing should be maintained with at least 6 feet between individuals whenever feasible.
6. Should any student contract and test positive for COVID-19, they must notify the instructor immediately. A positive test result in any non-quarantined student will result in the class going remote effective immediately.
7. Students experiencing COVID-like symptoms, as defined by CDC guidelines, are required to produce a negative test result before returning to class.
